
BOREHOLE HANDED OVER TO LOCAL FARMERS!



We are proud to have handed over a wind-powered borehole with accessories to the Bakgatla Ba Mmakau livestock farmers, addressing the pressing challenge of water scarcity in the Madibeng Local Municipality.

This borehole will provide a reliable water supply for approximately 300 cattle, easing the burden on local farmers. In addition to delivering this essential resource, the project created four temporary jobs during its implementation.
