



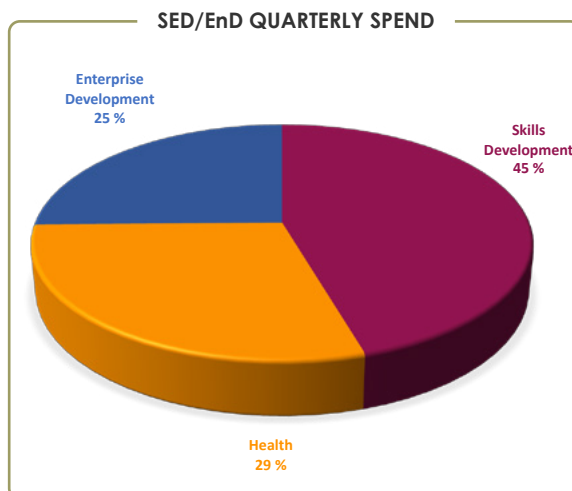
## LOCAL COACHES GAIN PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION
